Directions:

Always shake well before using. Never aim valve at face. Hold can upright and apply adhesive in a side-toside motion 8 to 12 inches from surface. For temporary bonds, spray surface, allow to become tacky, then bond surfaces together. For permanent bonds, liberally spray both the surface and material, allow to become tacky, then bond the surfaces together.

Not recommended for unsupported vinyl fabric. Certain plastic and elastomeric substrates can exhibit bond failure due to plasticizer migration. Combinations of high temperature and humidity can promote bond failure.
