Directions:

Apply coating to plow blades and other exposed metal and painted surfaces by spraying, brushing or rolling.

Equipment may be used immediately after application, but best results are obtained when coating is allowed to dry for 30 minutes.

For maximum protection, apply coating at the end of each work period. Several applications over the summer storage periods will preserve equipment.

This snow plow coating is deal for use on shovels, loaders, snow throwers and truck beds to help protect metal and allow easier, more complete dumping.
