5. Fire-Fighting Measures

SUITABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHING MEDIA:

Powder. Alcohol resistant foam. Carbon dioxide (CO2).

6. Accidental Release Measures

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS:

Keep unnecessary personnel away. Keep people away from and upwind of spill/leak. Keep out of low areas. Wear appropriate protective equipment and clothing during clean up. Avoid breathing gas. Do not touch damaged containers or spilled material unless wearing appropriate protective clothing. Ventilate closed spaces before entering them.
