

BARRICADE can be applied to any masonry, wood or metal surface. Surface should be properly prepared prior to application. Depending on the surface, additional steps may be required to prepare the surface for this anti-graffiti coating. Some surfaces will require fillers or base coats to insure optimal performance of BARRICADE.

After determining the surface on which BARRICADE will be applied, use the following guidelines to determine the steps necessary to apply the product.

## **Uncoated Concrete Block:**

**Step One:** Apply one coat of a Block Filler **Step Two:** Follow with one or two coats of a Base Coat **Step Three:** The surface is now ready to apply two coats of BARRICADE

## Uncoated Masonry with a Base Color:

**Step One:** Apply two coats of a pigmented Base Coat **Step Two:** The surface is now ready to apply two coats of BARRICADE

## **Uncoated Masonry Clear:**

**Step One:** Apply two coats of a Clear Masonry Sealer **Step Two:** The surface is now ready to apply two coats of BARRICADE
