SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE AND WHILE APPLYING THIS PRODUCT.

Never use repellents over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. When using sprays, do not spray directly into face; spray on hands first and then apply to face. Apply only to exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness; if biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Also, wash treated clothing before wearing it again. If after application you feel irritation, wash thoroughly with soap.
