



# PRODUCT BULLETIN

Product: **Anti-Seize** (173101), **Kote** (176701), **Boom Glide** (2783) and **Stick It** (195801)

---

Over the past few weeks, we have been notified of a few additional discontinued products. We are in the process of sourcing replacements, and we have been contacting some of you to test these new products for us. It is important that you have them tested as soon as possible so we can send the approval to the new supplier so they can begin production, and we can begin the label-proofing process here on our end.

Here is the list of products that have been discontinued with their status updates:

- **Anti Seize:** The new replacement product has an estimated ship date of 7/25. It will be called Anti Seize II and code is # 1155101. We have made the new product active in Netsuite so you can start placing orders for your customers and we will ship the product as soon as it arrives. Please see SDS and Product Information Sheet attached.
- **Kote:** We were just notified that this product is being discontinued, however we have about 3-4 months of inventory on hand. We are working to source a replacement product, but in the meantime, you may suggest **Chain & Cable Lube** or **XL 866** as alternative product options.

While not discontinued, **Boom Glide** and **Stick It** have been on back order for an extended period of time. Here are alternative non-stock products that you can recommend to your customers in the meantime...

- We don't have a ship date quite yet for **Boom Glide**, however we do have a special order grease, called **LifeGuard Plus**, that is available for your customers to order in 40 lb pails, 7 lb pails, and tubes.
- **Stick It** is also still being produced but has been on back order for a while with no estimated ship date. We are currently working on testing a replacement product, but in the meantime, you may suggest **Spray Adhesive Plus** (SP195811), which is a non-stock replacement item, while we work to find a permanent replacement.
