All Sport Freezer Pops

We are currently out of our All Sport Freezer Pops but hope to have them back in stock no later than July 22nd.

We understand that with high heat this summer all over the country, the demand for Freezer Pops have never been higher. When placing our most recent order, the supplier notified us that they were out of stock as well as limiting orders to only 88 cases per order.

To offset the limited supply, we have also ordered 88 cases of the All Sport Sugar Pops to keep in stock with our Sugar Free Pops which also should be in stock this week. We apologize for the delay and are doing our best to get them as fast as can. In addition, we plan to increase our inventory next spring to keep up the increased demand. Also, please recommend the powder sticks as an option while we are waiting for our next shipment of Freezer Pops.
